Jay Bardwell said Don Scott, head of student activities, will talk about the Student Activities Building. Scott said the building is a bit outdated. He talked about his supervisory duties as director of the building. There are normal housekeeping activities. He makes sure the information booth is staffed 16 hours a day. He looks after the game room. He makes sure the Union is properly programmed.

Bardwell asked about the new student union building. Bardwell said it has been a struggle to get a new building that they can call the campus activity center. The bid is going out at any time and they are expecting it to be completed in the fall of 1972. It will have in it dining facilities, a dance room, listening rooms, and a larger game room. Bardwell asked about funding. Scott said the students will be assessed a set fee per semester and the original financing is through a revenue bond. It is being paid for by the taxpayers of Alaska.

Bardwell asked when the building will be completed. Scott said the building will be capped and canned they should be underway with the building. By September 1972 the building should be completed. They will call it the Campus Activity Center.
