1982 University of Alaska Fairbanks commencement address

Karen Cedzo said according to Dr. Wagner leadership is a shared responsibility of both men and women. She is one of the nation's leading female figures in higher education. Wagner talked about support for public education. She said we have an unending resource in our people. Addressing the commencement class she said they represent the leaders of the future. She talked about the question of leadership, the importance of a higher education and stressed the characteristic of authenticity. She discussed not ignoring the majority of the population - the female population. Karen Cedzo said Dr. Wagner was the first female since 1956 to address a University of Alaska Fairbanks graduating class. Emily Ivanoff Brown and Claire Fejes received honorary doctorates.
