Karen Cedzo reported on the different programs available at the University of Alaska Fairbanks campus in the summer of 1982 including Elderhostel, fine arts music camp and summer session. The Tanana Valley Community College is offering an Elderhostel program and she explained what the national program is about and what courses will be offered. The 19th season of the UAF Summer Fine Arts Camp will take place in June and July and is open to junior and high school students. Four visiting guest faculty will participate in the summer camp. Marcella Lee will direct the camp musical, *The Music Man*. Suzanne Summerville has collaborated in the past on some of the musicals. Hal Sherman will instruct jazz ensembles including jazz improvisation. Henry Hedberg will direct the junior high school choir and the swing choir. Guest faculty Howard Judkins will discuss aspects of the music profession with camp students. Workshop on Alaska is a week of mini-courses and field trips designed to introduce visitors and Alaskans to the cultures, geography and history of the state. The first session of summer sessions closes June 25th and the second session is six weeks from July 5th until August 13th. The Fairbanks Summer Arts Festival is scheduled from July 26th until August 6th. Cedzo discussed some of the offerings including jazz and theater.

Cedzo said the University of Alaska Museum has new exhibits on the Trans-Alaska Pipeline and carved ivory. Guided walking tours are available daily.

Work continues on the Constitution Park on lower campus.
