The following tape (LENA SOURS - PRACTICES OF THE SHAMAN) was produced by KOTZ Radio Station in cooperation with Maniilaq Association and the Kotzebue Inupiat Ilitqusiatic Elders Council. The tape was recorded on Inupiaq Day at the Kotzebue Elementary School on April 13, 1983 and aired July 27 and 28, 1983.

The information on these tapes was recorded so that Kotzebue Elders could pass their historical and cultural knowledge on to their children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren. They are released to the Elmer Rasmuson Library, University of Alaska and the NANA Museum of the Arctic as part of the archival collection for "LENA SOURS - THE ARTIST BEHIND THE WORK."
