Dear Ms. Garcia:

Thank you for your letter asking for clarification on the restrictions regarding use of the public radio oil spill tape recordings. This letter outlines our restrictions in more detail, and supersedes our letter to Sherry Taber dated September 18, 1989.

KTOO FM & TV acted as coordinator for several different producers on this project, including National Public Radio, the Alaska Public Radio Network, KCHU in Valdez, KSKA in Anchorage, and our own station. It was our original intent that the tapes not circulate outside of the libraries. However, I believe the following terms will be acceptable to all of the producers:

1. Library reference copies are authorized.
2. No other duplication, in whole or in part, for any purpose, is permitted without written consent of the applicable producing organization.
3. No broadcast, sale or re-distribution of the recordings is permitted without written consent of the applicable producing organization.
4. Material on the tape recordings may be briefly quoted or referenced, in written form, provided credit is given the applicable producing organization.
5. Oral presentations are permitted only if intended for single-use, non-recorded presentations. Other oral presentations require the written consent of the applicable producing organization.


As for the issue of whether your library reference copies circulate, feel free to do whatever your own policy allows. However, if you do circulate the tapes for use outside the library, users must be informed of the above restrictions.


